




Actively listen to the user and their body language and reactions

Register positive feedback and reactions with :-)

Register negative feedback and reactions with :-(













Note-taker role summary

Your job is to take notes on how the user is <u>reacting</u> to the prototype – verbally and non-verbally

You do this by being hyper attentive to what is happening during the interview
